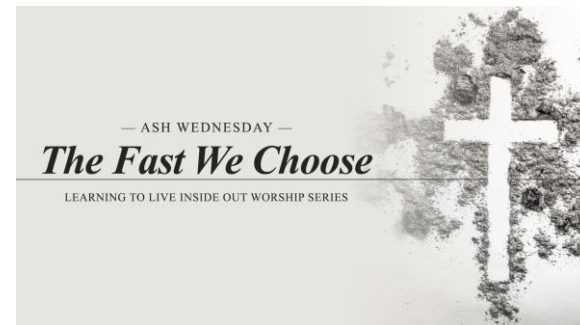
Welcome to worship at
