CVIM offers free medical care for those with a household income at or below 250% of the federal poverty level, seeking to ensure that all those who live and work in Centre County have access to health care services. As Centre County grows, so do the demands on the healthcare infrastructure around us. CVIM is in the middle of a capital campaign to help them move from their current 6,700 square foot space to a new facility with more than 11,000 square feet. The larger space will allow CVIM to provide more and broader services to those in the medical community who struggle to obtain medical care.

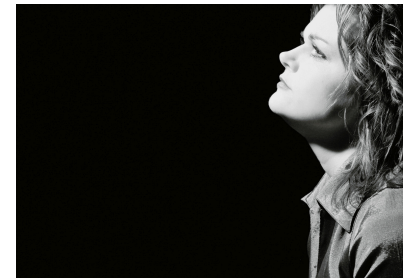
